

Words From This Verse Used 30 Times or Less in the NT – Acts 2:30

ὄρκω: noun, dative singular masculine < ὄρκος

an oath, Mt. 14:7, 9; 26:72; meton. that which is solemnly promised, a vow, Mt. 5:33 → oath.

ὤμοσεν: verb, 3rd person aorist active indicative singular < ὀμνύω

to swear, Mt. 5:34; to promise with an oath, Mk. 6:23; Acts 2:30; 7:17 → swear.

ὀσφύς: noun, genitive singular feminine < ὀσφύς

waist, loins, body; belt

⇒ the loins, Mt. 3:4; Mk. 1:6.
