

Words From This Verse Used 30 Times or Less in the NT – Acts 2:45

κτήματα: noun, accusative plural neuter < κτήμα

a possession, property, field, Mt. 19:22; Mk. 10:22; Acts 2:45; 5:1*

ὑπάρξεις: noun, accusative plural feminine < ὑπαρξις

existency or proprietorship, i.e. (concretely) property, wealth:--goods, substance.

ἐπίπρασκον: verb, 3rd person imperfect active indicative plural < πιπράσκω

to sell, Mt. 13:46; 18:25; met. with ὑπό, pass. to be sold under, to be a slave to, be devoted to, Rom. 7:14

διεμέριζον: verb, 3rd person imperfect active indicative plural < διαμερίζω

to divide, distribute

⇒ to divide into parts and distribute, Mt. 27:35; Mk. 15:24; Acts 2:3; pass. in NT to be in a state of dissension, Lk. 11:17, 18; 12:52, 53

καθότι: conjunction < καθότι

as, just as, according as, in proportion as, Acts 2:45; 4:35; inasmuch as, Lk. 1:7; 19:9; Acts 2:24; 17:31*
