συνέδραμεν: verb, 3rd person aorist active indicative singular < συντρέχω

to run together, flock together, Mk. 6:33; Acts 3:11; to run in company with others, met. 1 Pet. 4:4*

στοᾶ: noun, dative singular feminine < στοά

a colonnade, cloister, covered walk supported by columns, Jn. 5:2; 10:23; Acts 3:11; 5:12* → porch.

Σολομῶντος: noun, genitive singular masculine < Σολομῶν

Solomon

ἔκθαμβοι: adjective, nominative plural masculine < ἔκθαμβος

utterly astounded:--greatly wondering.
