

## Words From This Verse Used 30 Times or Less in the NT – Acts 3:12

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Ἰσραηλιῖται: noun, vocative plural masculine < Ἰσραηλίτης

an Israelite, a descendant of Ἰσραήλ, Israel or Jacob, Jn. 1:47; Acts 2:22

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ἀτενίζετε: verb, 2nd person present active indicative plural < ἀτενίζω

to look intently, gaze, stare

⇒ to fix one's eyes upon, look steadily, gaze intently, Lk. 4:20

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εὐσεβεία: noun, dative singular feminine < εὐσέβεια

reverential feeling; piety, devotion, godliness, Acts 3:12; 1 Tim. 2:2; 4:7, 8; religion, the Christian religion, 1 Tim. 3:16 → devotion; godliness.

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
