Ἄννας: noun, nominative singular masculine < Ἄννας

Annas, pr. name, short version of Ἄνανος, Lk. 3:2; Jn. 18:13, 24; Acts 4:6*

Καϊάφας: noun, nominative singular masculine < Καϊάφας

Caiaphas, pr. name, the high priest from A.D. 18-36, Mt. 26:3, 57; Lk. 3:2; Jn. 11:49; 18:13f., 28; Acts 4:6*

Ἀλέξανδρος: noun, nominative singular masculine < Ἀλέξανδρος

Alexander, pr. name. (1) The High Priest's kinsman, Acts 4:6. (2) A Jew of Ephesus, Acts 19:33. (3) The coppersmith, 1 Tim. 1:20; 2 Tim. 4:14. (4) Son of Simon of Cyrene, Mk. 15:21*

γένους: noun, genitive singular neuter < γένος

offspring, progeny, Acts 17:28, 29; family, kindred, lineage, Acts 7:13, et al.; race, nation, people, Mk. 7:26; Acts 4:36, et al.; kind, sort, species, Mt. 13:47, et al. → family; kind; offspring; people.

ἀρχιερατικοῦ: adjective, genitive singular neuter < ἀρχιερατικός

belonging to or connected with the high-priest or his office, Acts 4:6*

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
