καταλαβόμενοι: verb, aorist middle participle nominative plural masculine < καταλαμβάνω
to lay hold of, grasp; to obtain, attain, Rom. 9:30; 1 Cor. 9:24; Phil. 3:12, 13; to seize, to take possession of, Mk. 9:18; to come suddenly upon; overtake, surprise, Jn. 12:35; 1 Thess. 5:4; to detect in the act, seize, Jn. 8:3, 4; met. to comprehend, apprehend, Jn. 1:5; mid. to understand, perceive, Acts 4:13; 10:34; 25:25; Eph. 3:18* → catch; grasp; obtain; seize; understand.

ἀγράμματοί: adjective, nominative plural masculine < ἀγράμματος
illiterate, unlearned, Acts 4:13*

ἰδιῶται: noun, nominative plural masculine < ἰδιώτης
pr. one in private life, one devoid of special learning or gifts, a plain person, Acts 4:13; 2 Cor. 11:6; ungifted, 1 Cor. 14:16, 23, 24*
